12. The school should go through the process of Affiliation and Extension Bye-Laws and ensure that they are up to date. Any change in the Bye-Laws should be reported to the Board in time.
13. The school should ensure the safety of students including fire safety and other safety measures. The school should provide adequate facilities for sports, games and other recreational activities.
14. Admission to the school is to be restricted as per relevant rules of Examination Bye-Laws and other Bye-Laws of the Board of Affiliation Bye-Laws.
15. The school is required to follow the MoU, 2017 and 2018 of Affiliation Bye-Laws regarding Books and Quality of Education.
16. The number of sections in the school are restricted to 28 per number of sections reported by the IC. The number of sections shall not be increased without specific approval of the Board. For increase in number of sections, the school shall apply online to the Board as per rule 15.7 of Affiliation Bye-Laws.
17. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. The school shall also be liable to bear all legal charges incurred by the Board if any arising out of these circumstances.
18. The school must strive to promote conservation of environment on their campus through rain water harvesting, segregation of waste at source, recycling of organic waste, proper disposal of waste including electronic waste, use of energy saving and energy efficient electrical equipment, greening of campus, use of solar energy, education and awareness amongst children on environment conservation and cleanliness, etc.

20. The optimum Section teacher ratio of 1:1.5 as well as student teacher ratio of 30:1 is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board.
21. Every affiliated school shall sponsor regularly its bonafide and eligible students in Boards Class X and Class XII examinations from the year mentioned while granting affiliation/upgradeation regularly without break or inform with reasons thereof in writing well in time about the non-sponsoring of the candidates.
22. Running of coaching institutions in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not permitted by the Board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
23. The Manager and the Principal of the school shall be jointly responsible for the authenticity of the online/offline documents/information/data submitted by the School to the Board.
24. Apart from rules to be adhered to by the school as mentioned above for drawing specific attention of the school authorities, the school authorities are required to acquaint themselves with all the rules contained in Affiliation & Examination Bye-Laws and circulars/guidelines, notification issued by the Board from time to time. Any delay in following instructions of the Board will lead to action against school as per Chapter 12 of Affiliation Bye-Laws 2018.
25. The school shall be responsible to immediately comply with the conditions mentioned in the grant letter and shall also maintain record of certificates, compliances, data and other records/information and shall be fully responsible to produce all such records before Board when asked for. Failing which necessary action shall be taken as per Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board.
